Statement, question or imperative?

**"I will travel to London next week."**

**"Send me your email address."**

**"Are you from Marrakech?"**

**"Where are you from?"**





## GRAMMAR: Reported Speech 2

Direct Speech	Reported Speech
"I <b>will travel</b> to London next week."	He <b>said</b> that he <b>would travel</b> to London the following week.
" <b>Send</b> me an email." " <b>Don't call</b> me after 9pm."	She <b>told</b> me <b>to send</b> her an email. She <b>told</b> me <b>not to call</b> her after 9pm.
" <b>Are</b> you from Marrakech?"	She <b>asked</b> me <b>if I was from Marrakech</b> .
" <b>Where are</b> you from?"	He <b>asked</b> me <b>where I was from</b> .



# GRAMMAR: Reported Speech 2

**Statements**



**said + (that) + statement**

**Yes/No Questions**



**asked + if + Subject + Verb**

**Wh-Questions**



**asked + wh-word + Subject + Verb**

**Imperatives**



**told + infinitive (to/not to + verb)**
