Conditional Type 1


If you work hard, you will have good scores.

GRAMMAR: Present Wish & Conditional Type 2

Situation: I don't have a smartphone because I don't have enough money.

I wish I had enough money to buy a new smartphone. If only I had enough money to buy a new smartphone.

Present Wish

wish + simple past If only + simple past



GRAMMAR: Present Wish & Conditional Type 2

Situation: I *don't have* a smartphone *because* I don't have enough money.

Conditional Type 2

If I had enough money, I would buy a new smartphone. I would buy a new smartphone If I had enough money.

If + S. Past + would/could/might + Verb





GRAMMAR: Past Wish & Conditional Type 3

Situation: Last year I didn't have good scores because I didn't work hard enough.

I wish I had worked hard enough last year. If only I had worked hard enough last year.

wish + past perfect If only + past perfect

Past Wish






